Then in August, we moved house and have now settled in well. Since then, I've been out most days across Kent, sharing the gospel in towns and on the streets. On average, we're seeing two or three people come to Christ every month, most of them young men hungry for truth and hope.

One of our outreach team members in Maidstone is currently doing the online Evangelism Training, and I have the privilege of mentoring him. It's such a joy to see others growing in confidence to share their faith!
